

## LETTER OF AGREEMENT

Hello,

The purpose of this letter of agreement is to outline the limits and allowances for your use of The Moth's curriculum resources. Because these resources represent pilot materials for The Moth Education Program, we need to ensure that they will not be exploited for gain or used in a way that would misrepresent the trademarked brand, The Moth. We also want to make sure you use them in a way that will be safe for your students!

By accepting this agreement, and in return for receiving our resources free of charge, you agree that:

- You are a classroom teacher or school counselor in a K-12 school, requesting these materials for use in the school setting and not outside of it.
- You will not distribute these materials to other educators or outside organizations without express permission from Moth EDU. You can always email us to ask if you can share the resources with other teachers and administrators. We would like to keep track of who is using these materials.
- You will not brand any of your own materials that you create, whether or not they are inspired by these materials, as Moth brand materials.
- At the bottom of any materials you create with support from these resources, you will include "made with support by The Moth Education Program."
- You will not hold public or for-profit workshops or shows using materials received by The Moth Education Program. (This does NOT include school shows.)
- If you create a storytelling club or after school, you will not call it The Moth. "Moth-inspired" is great, or we encourage you to think of your own fun name for it. There will be future opportunities to attend training at an institute for educators, starting Spring 2017, after which teachers can be certified to run a Moth StorySLAM.
- You will give us some feedback about the materials and let us know what was useful and what was not, and (to the extent you're comfortable) share materials that you've created about storytelling. This feedback might be in the form of an email, submitted materials, a phone interview, or another form, depending on your availability, preference and the availability of Moth staff.

**For our part, The Moth Education Program agrees to:**

- Provide you with a collection of educational resources, access to selected stories by Moth students, and other useful information to support you as you teach storytelling or use stories in your classroom/school community.
- Have Moth curatorial staff review any submitted audio of stories you or your students have recorded for possible inclusion on The Moth website, in The Moth Radio Hour, podcast or in a future book. If this were to be the case, we would create a separate legal release.
- If desired and applicable, list you on The Moth website as a contributing partner to our resources, as a thank you for your help in piloting this project.
- Ask for your permission before we distribute any materials you create as a result of these resources, credit you properly as the creator of specific materials you have created, and credit you as a co-creator of the curriculum resources that develop.

Additional responsibilities may arise, and would be compensated with the further agreement between you (the educator) and us (The Moth Education Program).
